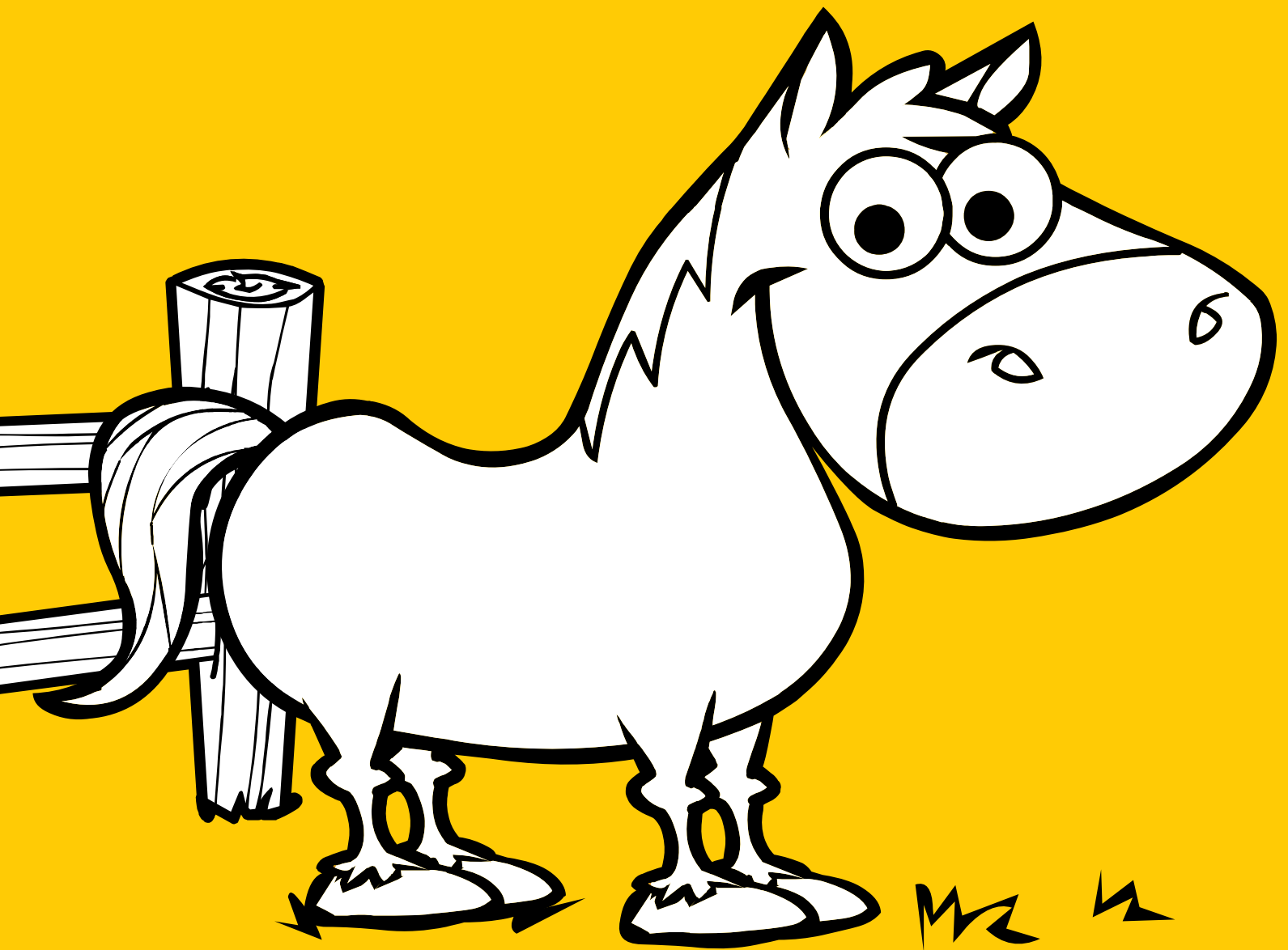


# FARM ANIMALS

**Skills:** Animal recognition and facts, reading left to right, vocabulary building

**Parents:** Read the sentence to your child, following with your finger from left to right. Ask your child questions, such as “Do you know what *gallop* means? To run fast.” Have your child color the horse.

Horses gallop very fast.

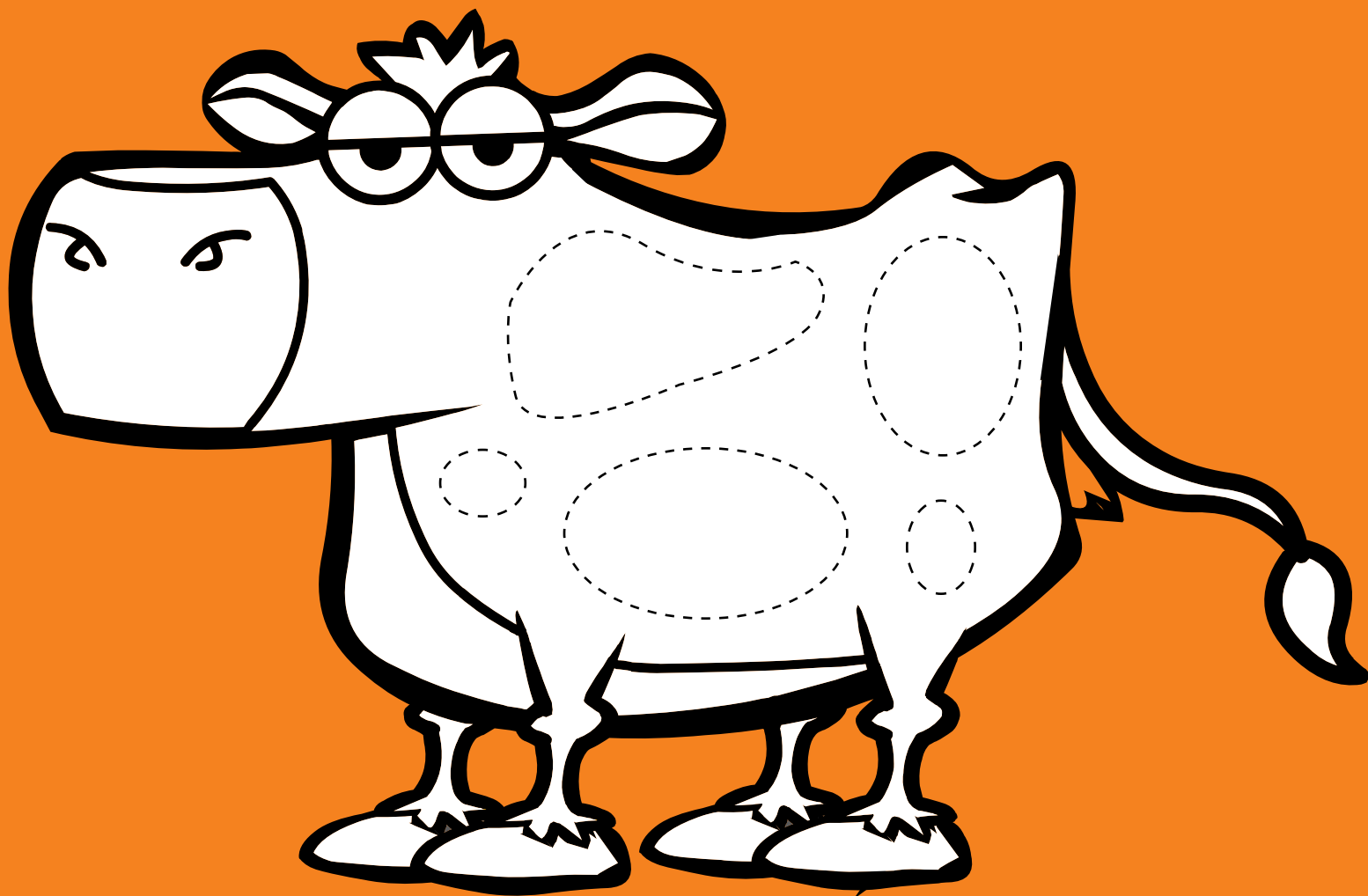


# FARM ANIMALS

**Parents:** Read the sentence to your child, following with your finger from left to right. Ask your child questions, such as “Do you know what *grazing* means? To eat grass.” Have your child draw black spots on the cow.

Cows graze in the fields.

**Skills:** Animal recognition and facts, reading left to right, vocabulary building

**Parents:** Read the sentence to your child, following with your finger from left to right. Ask your child questions, such as “Do you know what *herds* are? Groups of animals.” Have your child finish drawing the goat by tracing the dotted line.

Goat herds like to walk through the hills.
