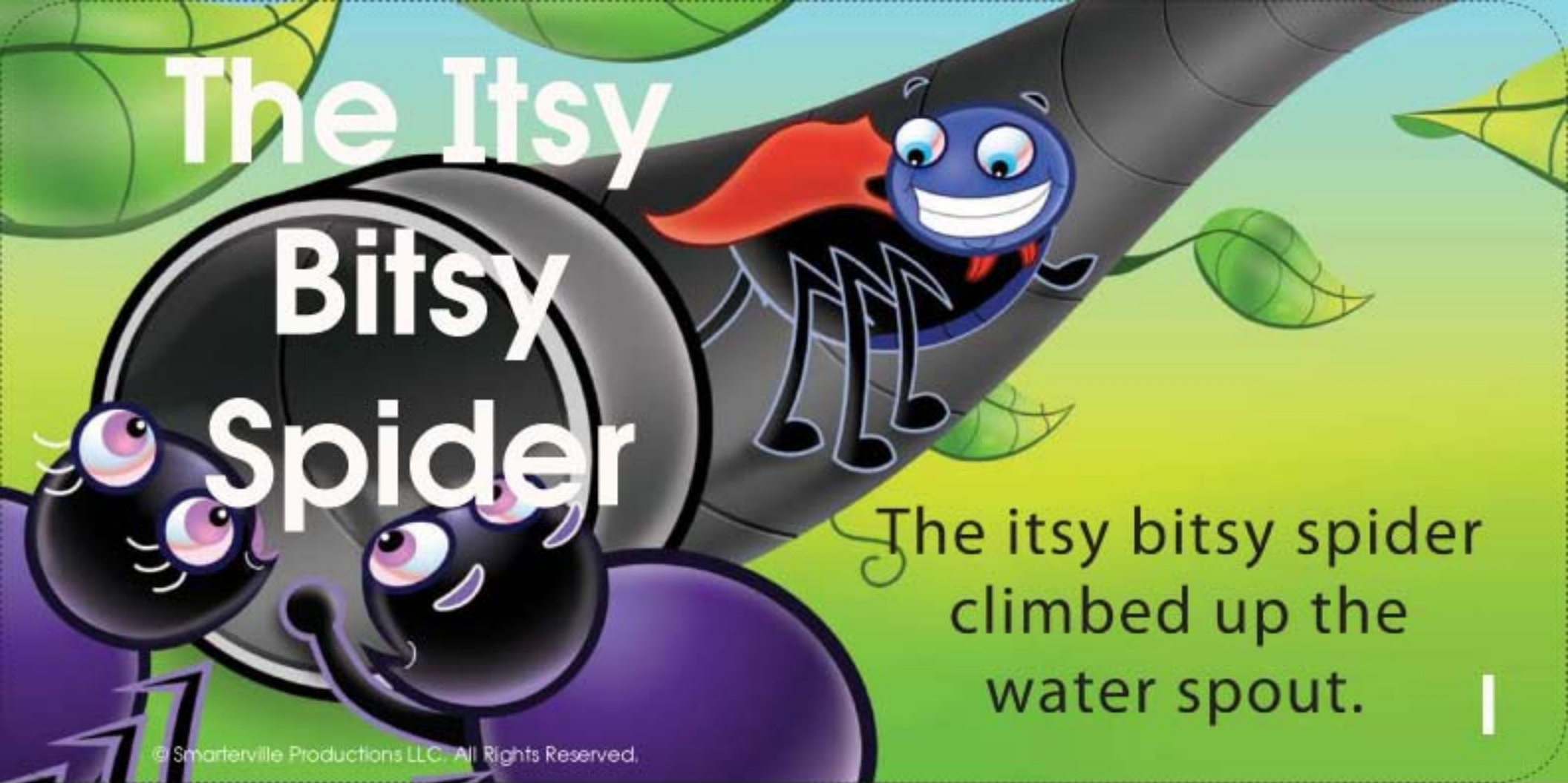


The Itsy Bitsy Spider

In just 20 minutes, your child can practice reading fluently by watching our Learn to Read Itsy Bitsy Spider video, and by printing out the companion book, it's free! Just follow these simple instructions:

1. Print out this Itsy Bitsy Spider book. You can print the pages in full color or black and white.
2. Cut on the dotted lines.
3. Stack the pages in order, from page 1 to page 6.
4. Staple the pages on the left hand side.
5. Now, watch the Itsy Bitsy Spider video with your child and read along with the book (www.blog.learntoread.com).
6. Have your child read the book out loud a few times. Make sure he's reading with correct pauses, expression, pronunciation, tone, etc.

At the end of this activity your child's level of fluency will have increased, and he'll be one step closer to becoming a great reader.

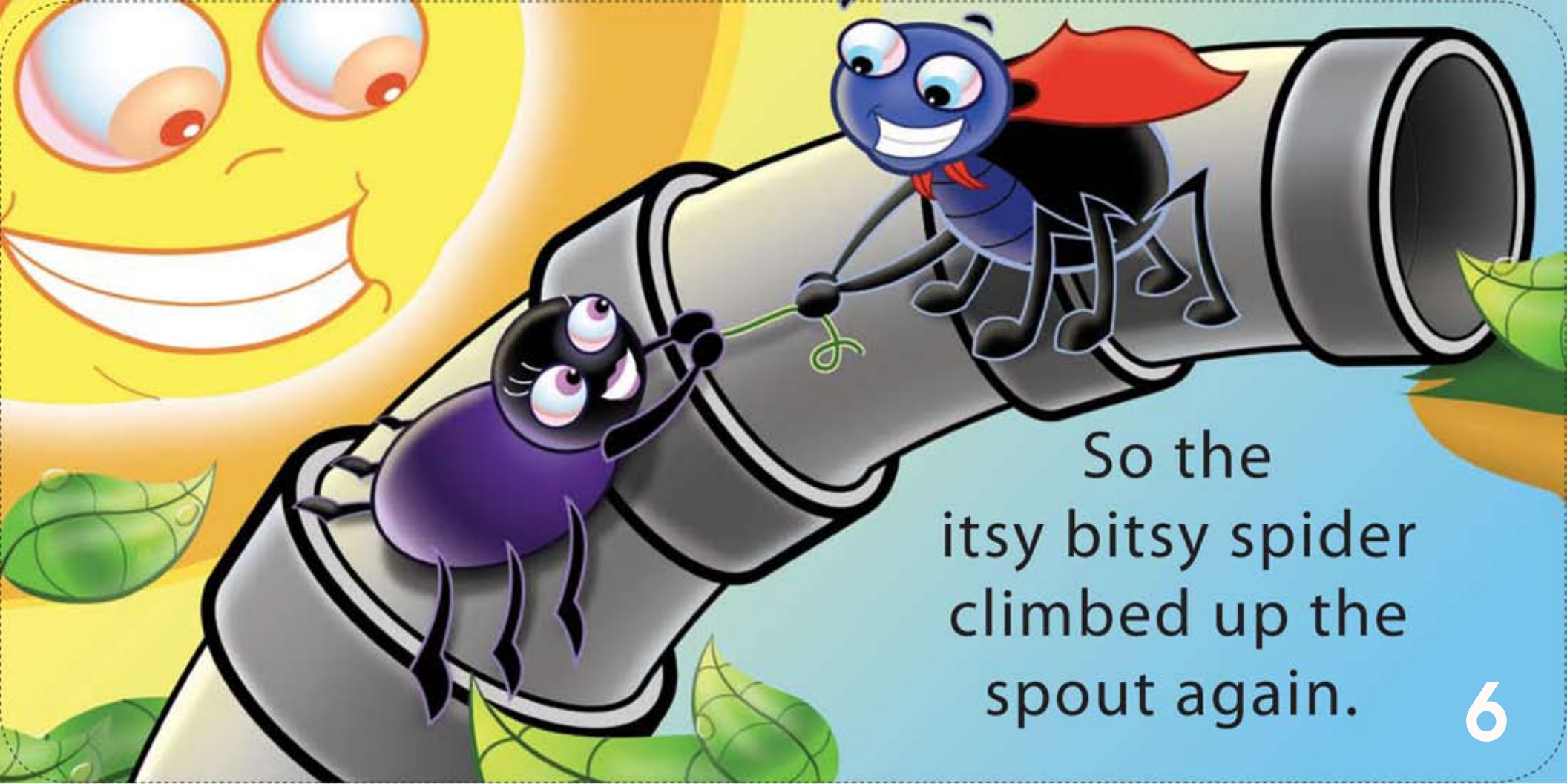
